

Challenge Arran – Golf Pass Marathon

Saturday June 16th 2018

The Isle of Arran with its seven golf courses is in the unique position to offer a golf marathon to locals and visitors. There will be prizes for the players who get round all seven courses with the lowest score between the hours of 4am and 11pm.

The competition is in peak season to maximise the hours of daylight as competitors will have to cover 93 holes of golf over 13.2 miles (based on published course yardage) plus driving between clubs.

How to enter

The event requires players to purchase the £110 Golf Pass. Players or teams can enter by visiting <http://www.golfonarran.com/arrangolfpass.html> and paying in the usual way by PayPal. Please add in the notes section that you are entering the Marathon, and details of all team members and their contact details. The Golf Passes will then be posted out to you.

Fitness requirements

As with any sporting competition competitors must be at a fitness level satisfactory to meet the criteria of the event. Whilst not as demanding as running a full marathon you will be covering a distance equal to a half marathon over varied terrain. The nine hole courses Lochranza, Corrie and Machrie do not have golf buggies but the remaining courses do, so it is advised that buggies be reserved in advance for those who need them.

Handicap

Handicaps will not enter into the formula for the competition, purely scoring on the day.

Tee markers

Players should play off the yellow tee markers, not the competition or shorter markers.

Four ball

Competitors can play in four ball teams, please announced team names before the start of the competition.

Transport

Each team will have to arrange its own transportation.

Charities

Teams or players can play for a charity of their choosing if they wish to do so.

Weather

The competition is a tough one come rain or shine and will go ahead regardless of weather conditions which is all part of the competition.

Rules

Entrants will adhere to club rules

Results

Scorecards should be submitted at the end of the competition.

Presentation

The results and prizes will be announced at Brodick Golf Club, 21:00 after all competitors have finished or abandoned the competition. There will be prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd and the Wooden Spoon!
